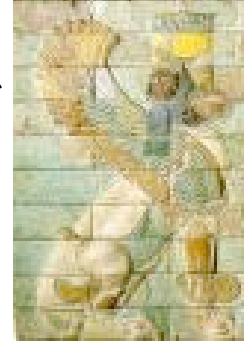

“Lumps, Bumps, and Sores: A Guide to the Diagnosis and Management of Soft Tissue Lesions”

This course will review the classification and clinical features of common oral pathological conditions as well as practice guidelines for evaluating, documenting, and following soft tissue lesions over time. The review will also include recent developments related to bisphosphonate therapy and osteonecrosis of the jaws.

- Develop a differential diagnosis for mucosal lesions based on primary clinical features
- Recognize current practice guidelines for evaluating, documenting, and following soft tissue lesions over time

Dr. Reynolds holds a Ph.D. in oral and experimental pathology, a master's degree in clinical psychology, and a specialty certificate in periodontics. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology, a Fellow of both the American and International Colleges of Dentists, and serves as Chair, Department of Periodontics, and Director of Postgraduate Periodontics at the University of Maryland. Dr Reynolds has contributed nearly 90 scientific publications in the fields of aging, periodontics, and pathology.
